






WATER RESISTANCE CHART

Each and every **traser** watch in the current collection is tested (air pressure test) during production up to its relative pressure reference.

All **traser** bracelets and straps are manufactured to allow daily contact with water. For intensive in- and underwater usage, we only recommend our metallic bracelets or rubber straps.

	Metric Scale Bar / Meters (m)	Imperial Scale Pound per square inch (psi) / Feet (ft)
	3 bar / 30m	40 psi / 100 ft
	10 bar / 100m	140 psi / 330 ft
	20 bar / 200m	280 psi / 660 ft

Notice: Watches resistant to water up to above specified depth. A watch's water resistance cannot be permanently guaranteed. It may notably be affected by the ageing of gaskets or by a shock on the case. It is recommended to have the water resistance of your watch checked once a year by an authorized traser Service Center.
